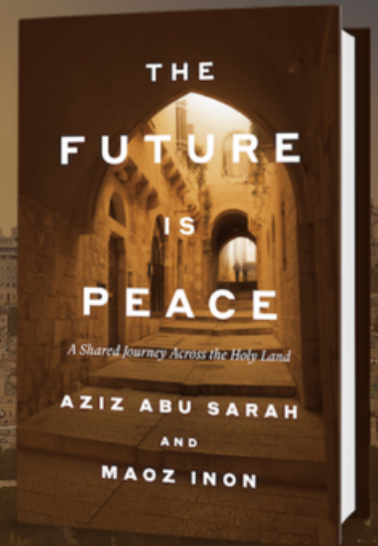

Travel with peacebuilders and co-authors Aziz Abu Sarah and Maoz Inon through Israel and Palestine on an immersive journey following the arc of their book, *The Future is Peace*. From opposing sides of a longstanding conflict they guide you through their homeland, sharing their experiences and how it shaped them.

ITINERARY & INFORMATION

February 16: Welcome & Orientation

Transfer to the first hotel (transfer options will be provided). In the evening, join the group for a welcome dinner and introductions.

Overnight in Tel Aviv (Dinner included)*

*Pre-stays can be arranged for those arriving early.

February 17: Southern Israel-Gaza Envelope

Meet Aziz and Maoz for an opening orientation, setting the tone for your Dual Narrative journey with curiosity, active listening, and respect.

Travel south to the Gaza border communities ("Gaza Envelope"), stopping at a scenic overlook to explore the region's geopolitical realities and daily life.

Visit Netiv HaAsara, where Maoz shares his personal story of loss, resilience, and the human impact of October 7 and the years of conflict leading up to it.

Overnight in Tel Aviv (Breakfast, Lunch included)

February 18: Identity, Activism, and Aspirations

Begin in Jaffa, exploring its layered history while engaging with a Palestinian activist on identity, the Nakba, and the lived experience of Palestinian citizens of Israel.

Meet with a Jewish-Arab grassroots movement advancing equality and shared society; alternatively, engage with Physicians for Human Rights Israel on healthcare access and humanitarian realities in Gaza.

Visit Netiv HaAsara, where Maoz shares his personal story of loss, resilience, and the human impact of October 7 and the years of conflict leading up to it. Travel to Jerusalem to check-in to the next hotel.

Overnight in Jerusalem (Breakfast, Lunch included)



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ITINERARY & INFORMATION

February 19: Dual Narratives of Jerusalem

Explore Jerusalem's Old City on a full-day Dual Narrative journey, walking its four quarters as your guides share the intersecting, and at times conflicting, histories and perspectives. Discuss sacred space, contested sovereignty, and the spiritual and national significance Jerusalem holds for multiple communities.

In the afternoon, continue to East Jerusalem to explore contemporary realities, including a visit to the Educational Bookshop for a conversation on literature, identity, and Palestinian intellectual life.

Overnight in Jerusalem (Breakfast, Lunch included)

February 20: West Bank-Bethlehem

Travel into the West Bank to explore Bethlehem and its surrounding areas. Meet with representatives from Combatants for Peace, a joint Israeli-Palestinian movement of former fighters who now advocate for nonviolent resistance and reconciliation.

Visit Aziz's family home in Bethany for a personal window into Palestinian daily life and family history.

Tour Bethlehem, including: The Separation Barrier, A local refugee camp, and The Walled Off Hotel (Banksy Hotel), where art and activism intersect. Return to Jerusalem in the evening.

Overnight in Jerusalem (Breakfast, Lunch included)

February 21: Nazareth

Travel north to Nazareth, Israel's largest Arab city, for an overview of 1948 and its lasting impact on identity, civic life, and economic development among Palestinian citizens of Israel.

Nazareth (continued)

Hear Maoz's journey into social entrepreneurship, including the founding of the Fauzi Azar Inn—now a cultural education center dedicated to dialogue and cross-cultural exchange.

Conclude with meetings with local entrepreneurs reshaping Nazareth's economy, exploring how grassroots initiatives foster dignity, shared life, and renewed hope.

Overnight in Nazareth (Breakfast, Lunch included)



February 22: Jesus Trail

Explore the natural and historical landscapes of the Galilee region. Visit Kibbutz Lavi, The Horns of Hattin—site of the pivotal 1187 battle between Crusader and Muslim forces, The ancient Mount Arbel ruins overlooking the Sea of Galilee, Tabgha.

Throughout the day, reflect on how sacred geography, memory, and narrative shape both religious imagination and modern political identity.

In the evening, gather for a closing briefing and guided reflection session.

One group transfer will be made following dinner to the Ben Gurion International airport for evening departures.

OPTIONAL EXTENSION: HEBRON

Hebron & South Hebron Hills with Breaking the Silence

Date: February 23 - 24 , 2027

Join MEJDI and Breaking the Silence for a day of exploration and learning in Hebron and the South Hebron Hills. Led by a former Israeli soldier and educator from Breaking the Silence, this experience offers firsthand insight into daily life, military occupation, and settlement activity in one of the most complex regions of the West Bank.

Following the Future is Peace Tour, participants will spend an additional night in Jerusalem before departing on November 1 for Hebron. The day includes visits to the Old City, Shuhada Street, and communities in the South Hebron Hills, where travelers will learn about the experiences of both Palestinian and Israeli residents, the challenges facing rural communities, and the realities of life in Area C.

The tour will return to Jerusalem around 5pm. You may depart for the airport or continue with the Olive Harvest following this tour.

Price: \$275 per person (shared room), \$400 per person (single room)
